Materials You'll Need

- Yarn: 100% cotton or cotton blend yarn in light worsted weight (approx. 200m/50g)
- Hook: 3.5mm (US E/4)
- Scissors
- Yarn needle
- Measuring tape
- Optional: Buttons or other embellishments

Skill Level

This pattern is suitable for both beginner and experienced crocheters. Basic crochet stitches, such as single crochet, double crochet, and slip stitch, are used throughout. The pattern also includes detailed instructions for any special stitches or techniques required.

Pattern Instructions

Note: The pattern includes detailed instructions for all three sizes (12m, 3yrs, 4yrs UK). Please refer to the pattern for specific measurements and yarn requirements.

Size 12m

1. **Foundation Row:** Chain (ch) 96, join with a slip stitch (sl st) to form a ring.
2. **Round 1:** Ch 1, single crochet (sc) 2 into the ring, *ch 1, sk 1, sc 3 into the next st, repeat from * around, sl st to join. (96 sc)

3. **Round 2:** Ch 1, sc 2 into each st around, sl st to join. (192 sc)
4. **Round 3:** Ch 1, *sc 2 into the next st, sc 1 into the next st, repeat from * around, sl st to join. (192 sc)
5. **Rounds 4-10:** Repeat Round 3.
6. **Round 11:** Ch 1, *sc 2 into the next st, ch 1, sc 1 into the next st, repeat from * around, sl st to join. (192 sc, 96 ch-1 spaces)
7. **Sleeve 1:** Join yarn at the underarm and ch 20, sc 1 into the next 4 sts, ch 1, turn. Now follow the sleeve edging pattern below.
8. **Sleeve 2:** Repeat Sleeve 1 on the other side of the top.
9. **Sleeve Edging:**
 - **Round 1:** Sc 1 into each st around, sl st to join.
 - **Round 2:** Ch 1, *sc 1 into the next st, sc 2 into the next st, repeat from * around, sl st to join.
 - **Round 3:** Ch 1, *sc 2 into the next st, sc 1 into the next st, repeat from * around, sl st to join.
 - **Round 4:** Repeat Round 3.
 - **Round 5:** Ch 1, *sc 1 into the next st, picot stitch (ch 3, sl st into the 1st ch) into the next st, repeat from * around, sl st to join.
10. **Neckline:** Ch 1, sc around the top edge of the body, inc 1 sc into each ch-1 space. Sl st to join.
11. **Neckline Edging:** Follow the sleeve edging pattern from Round 2 onward.

12. **Finishing:** Weave in any loose ends, sew on any embellishments, and block the top to shape.

Size 3yrs

Follow the same instructions as for Size 12m, but with the following modifications:

- Foundation Row: Ch 112
- Round 2: Sc 2 into each st around
- Round 11: 112 sc, 56 ch-1 spaces

Size 4yrs

Follow the same instructions as for Size 3yrs, but with the following modifications:

- Foundation Row: Ch 128
- Round 11: 128 sc, 64 ch-1 spaces

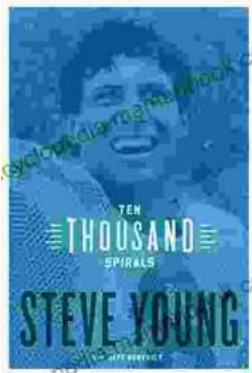


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
