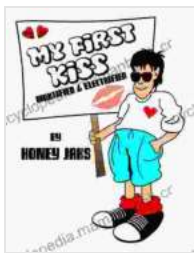


My First Kiss: A Mortifying and Electrifying Experience

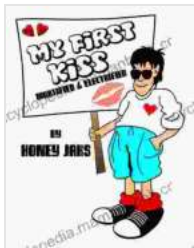
