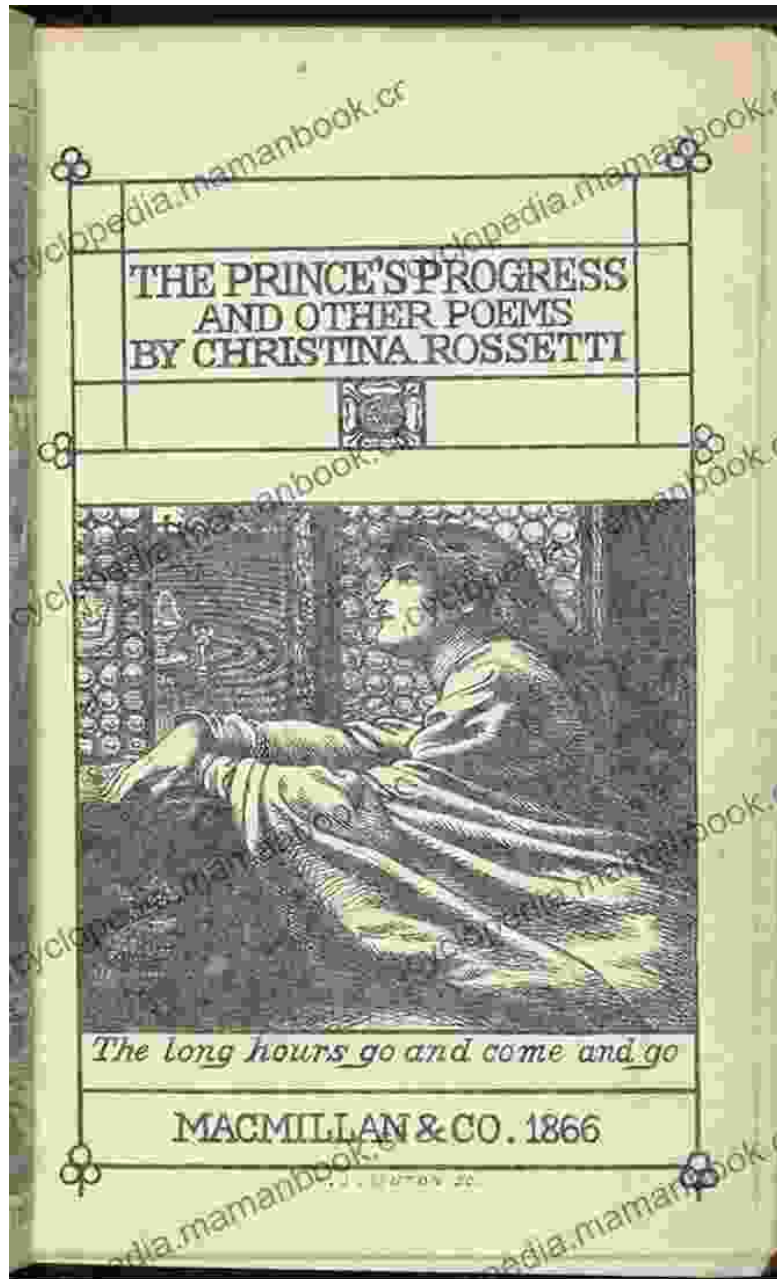


Illustration of Goblin Market by Arthur Rackham

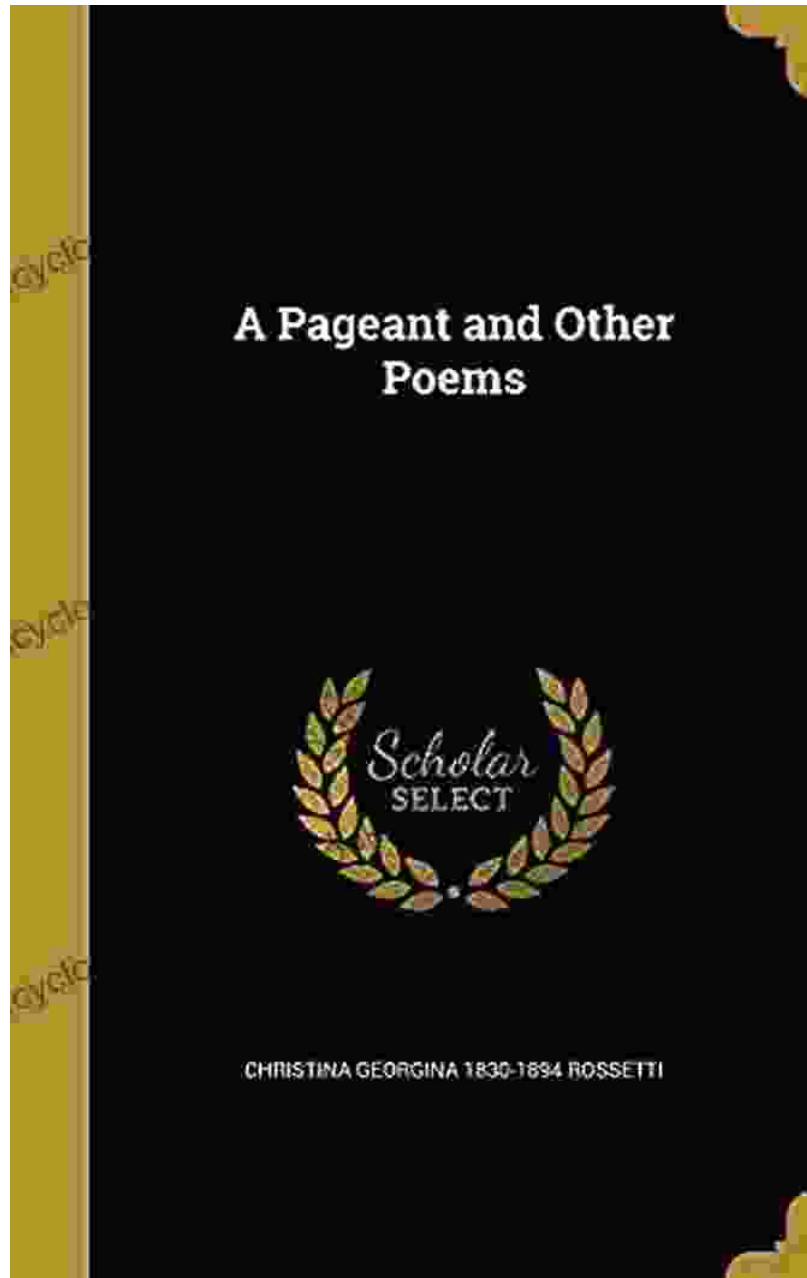


Illustration of A Pageant and Other Poems by Marie Spartali Stillman

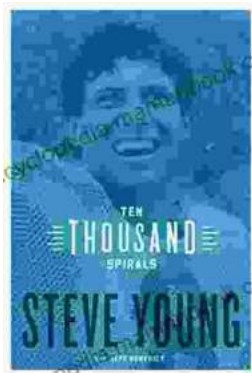
